

Harlem Mystery Building Gets a Name: Windows on 123

There wasn't a peep from the Above 96th crowd, but the new year brings new info: Uptown Flavor [now points](#) to a new [teaser website](#) for the development, ID'd as **Windows on 123**.

For now, the website merely features typical boasts ("Leave cramped floor plans and inadequate amenities in your most distant memories") and a sales office address of 117 West 123rd Street. The contact form lists a price range of **\$549,000 to \$1.6 million** on its units, sized 1-3BRs. Corcoran is handling the sales and marketing.
